2 Splat Turtle

Splat the Turtle loves being creative with splatters of paint.

Which shapes and colours can you spot around Splat's home?

Take inspiration from the walls here, and create your own colourful splatter artwork at home.



3 Fairmuir Fox

Fairmuir fox loves creating things to wear from found things in the park.

Can you design a leafy pattern or something for fox to wear on the train today?

4 Bramble Bat

Bramble loves living in the Miley, flying up and down like the train a hundred years ago.

Can you move fast and loudly like a train? Can you spot any flowers or berries along the way?



5 Ollie Rabbit

Take a moment to relax.

What can you spot from the top of the hill? Imagine what might be lurking down in the Tey.

Can you spot the love locks? Think of a favourite person you might make a love lock for.



6 Mr Shoe the Squirrel

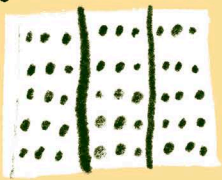
Mr Shoe likes exploring shoe tree. Pick a pair of shoes for squirrel to wear on the train today.

Moonbeam Moth flies around the lights of the multistorey flats at night, but is sleepy in daytime.

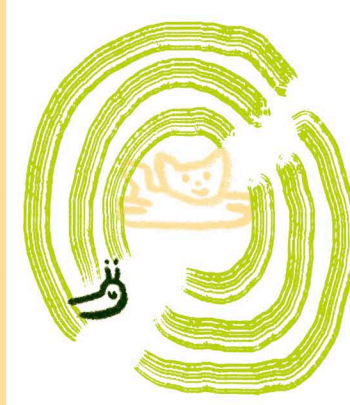
Reflect on people and places that make you feel bright and light, and make a bedtime story to tell Moonbeam.

Coldside cat loves creeping around the tiny pocket park, spotting tiny sounds and tiny creatures.

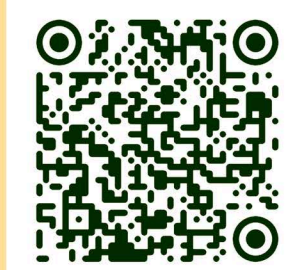
Can you become a cat?
